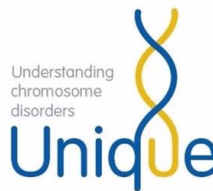
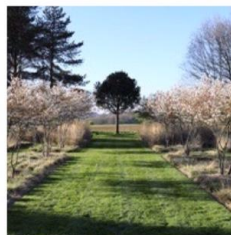


Open Garden
