ONLINE SAFETY



We have been looking at Internet Safety all this week. On National Internet Safety Day on Tuesday we showed two films made by pupils in year 9 that demonstrated how to keep safe online. The first made by 9G looked at the issue of 'griefing' which is where other people enter online games that you are playing and destroy them. We talked about how to avoid this happening to you.

The Second film, made by 9C, told the story of Mr Chatterbox who suddenly goes very quiet and it was discovered that people had been unkind to him on the Internet. Things improved once he told a teacher and they were able to deal with it.
