## **Great Oaks Expansion Update**

Plans are progressing well for the extension to Great Oaks School with the designs for the new build being finalised.

The building which will be built where the current Vermont School is situated will enable us to take up to another 150 young people. It will include sensory rooms, specialist teaching rooms (including music, art, food technology and science), a drama studio and sports hall.

Building on the site is due to start in July / August 2025 with the first stage complete for us move in September 2026.
