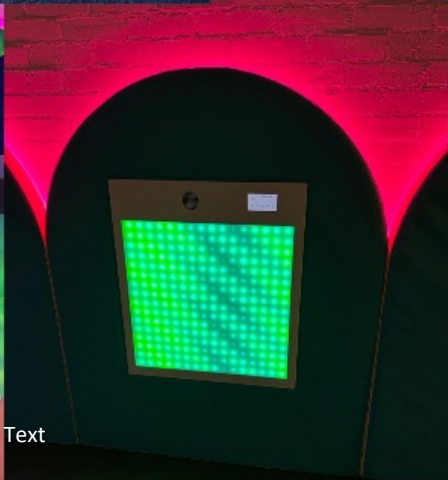

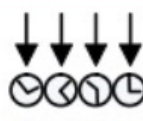




Skills Builder Challenge

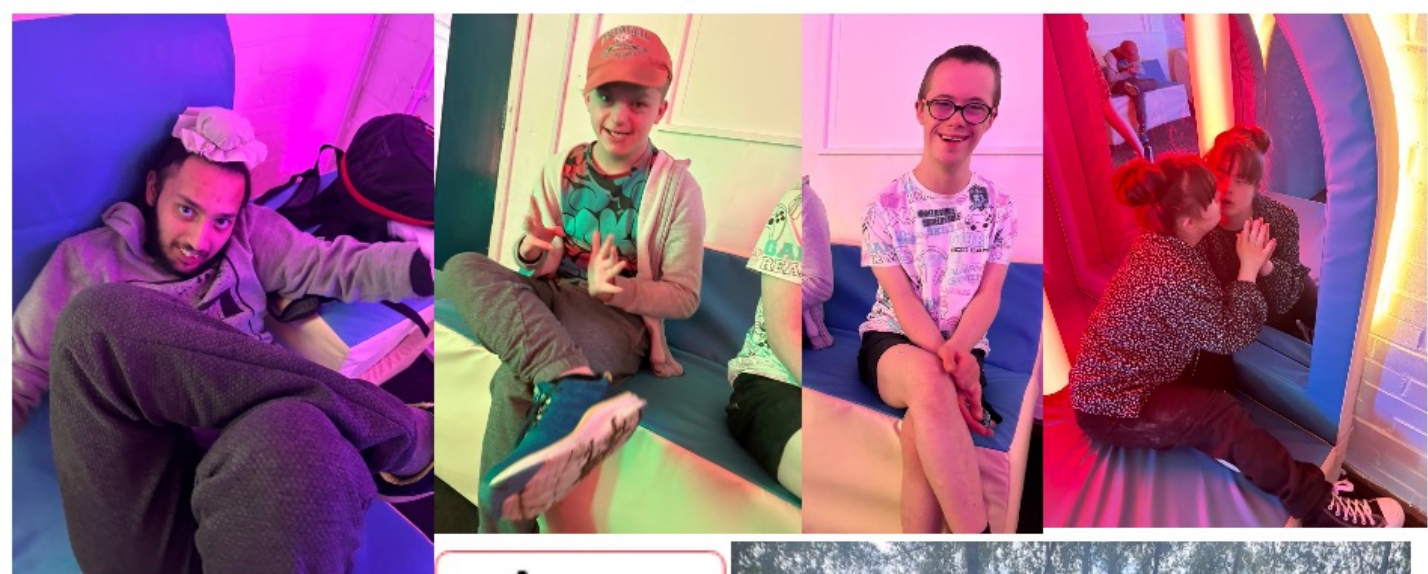


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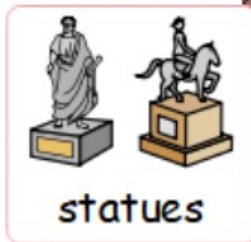




D16 have enjoyed time in the new sensory room this week. It was lovely to explore the different sensory equipment in there such as the lights, vibration and music.
