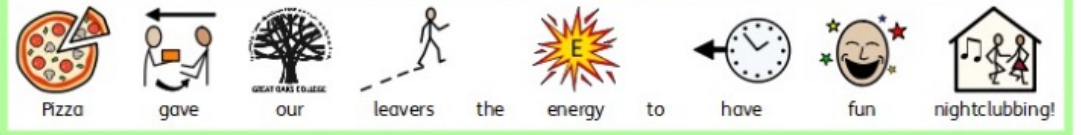

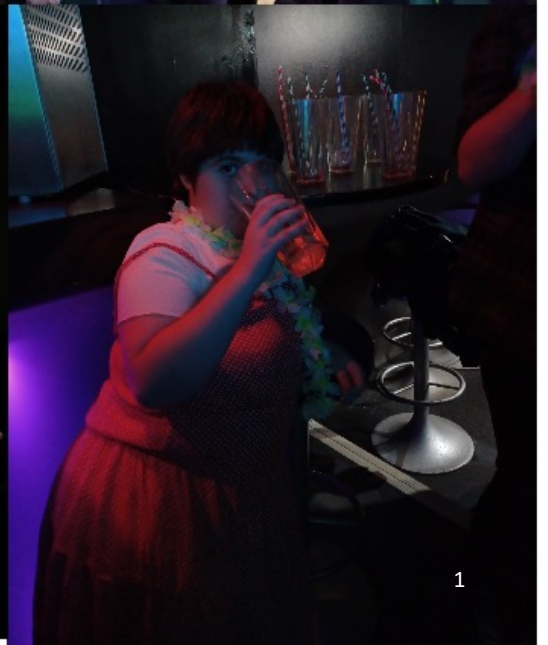
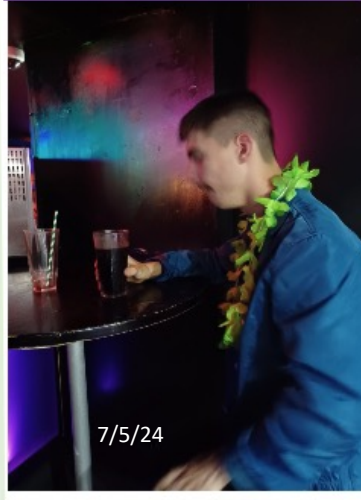
Afternoon everyone!

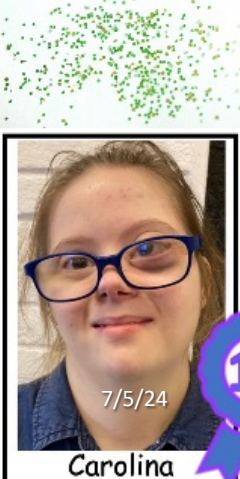

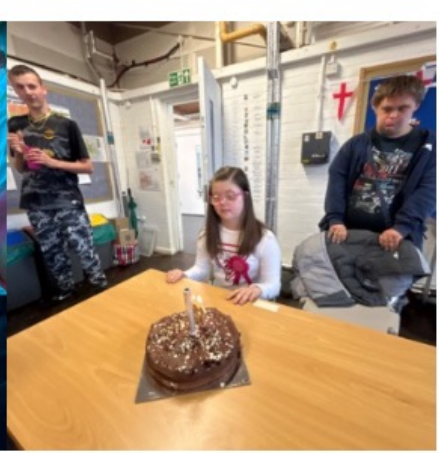
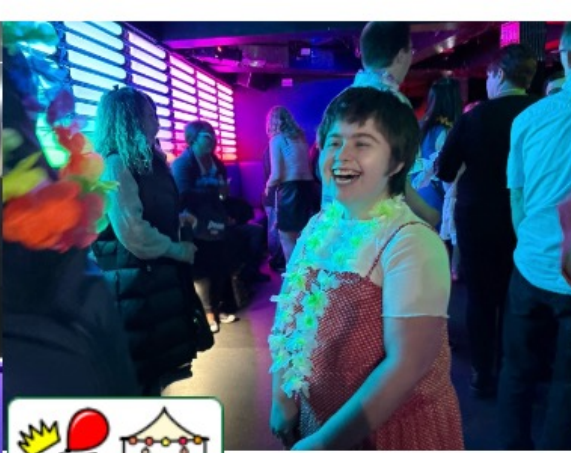
